INTRODUCTION

You are about to read a comprehensive description of your personality and character that will amaze you (and the people who know you) with its accuracy. It is based on an analysis of your unique horoscope, but there are none of the symbols in your horoscope shown in this report; instead, you will find just a clear report in plain English. However, if you are interested, you can find a print-out of your horoscope, with all its symbols, at the end of this report.

So what's the point of this report? It will enable you to know yourself in a more comprehensive way than any other way of understanding human nature can offer. It will give you the depth of self-awareness that some people achieve through years of psychoanalysis; but it is all here on these pages without any of the struggles or expense of prolonged analysis!

From the awareness you gain, you will realise that you - like everyone else - have contradictory parts in your nature that you have so far been unaware of but that deeply affect your ways of being in the world and your relationships. Out of this awareness, you will be able to make conscious choices in accordance with your true nature, rather than being compulsively driven by inner daemons that seem out of your control. You will be able to save a great deal of energy and to make easier and better decisions, decisions that acknowledge and reconcile the contradictions in your nature rather than expressing some parts of yourself at the expense of others.

Nobody knows exactly how our horoscopes work to define our personality and character so accurately; but astrology has been known and practised in every known culture for more than two thousand years.

Some people reject astrology on the grounds that it is fatalistic, but they are wrong. It is no more fatalistic than genetics, which determines the color of our eyes, the shape of our noses, mouths, our skin color, and thousands of other inherited characteristics. Indeed, a good way to think of your horoscope is as a map of your genetic inheritance. No horoscope is 'better' or 'worse' than any other. We are each dealt 'a hand' from 'the whole pack', and our contentment with our lives depends on how well we play out our own hand. A hand full of court cards and trumps can be as boring to play as a hand with only low cards played with skill and attention can be joyful. What gives us our greatest contentment is making 'the most and the best' rather than 'the worst and the least' of who we innately are.

Our completed personalities and characters are the outcome of the interaction of our genetic inheritance and our childhood environmental experiences. Environment certainly has a role to play - witness, for example, the noticeably increased height of recent generations, and our increased longevity due to nutrition and hygiene - but contemporary research makes clear that genetics is the overwhelmingly dominant determiner of what we are, both physically and psychologically.

Genetics sets limits on our potential, but within those limits there is huge scope for the expression of our freewill. It is pointlessly frustrating for a five-foot tall man to want only to be an Olympic high-jumper; on the other hand, it is a sad waste of potential for a woman endowed with a beautiful voice to content herself with singing in the shower. This report will enable you to recognize and give up unrealistic ambitions you may have and to discern potentials in yourself so far untapped.

And for all of us there are various and often divergent options for fulfilling our potentials within the boundaries of our given attributes. As you read through this report, you will almost certainly find some of the paragraphs mutually contradictory. This reflects the complexity inherent in all human beings. If you have been able to supply the time (as well as the date and place) of your birth, one of the most illuminating parts of this report is likely to be the first section, 'Your presentation, mask and appearance'. It describes the immediate impression you make on other people, which might be unfamiliar to your knowledge of yourself. The people who know us intimately see beyond our mask to our 'real self' (which may be quite different from our mask), the immediate impression we make on other people in a casual way has enormous importance in our everyday life.
